Notification regarding the electronic Apostille Programme (e-APP)

The Permanent Bureau of the HCCH is pleased to inform the Competent Authorities designated under the *Convention of 5 October 1961 Abolishing the Requirement of Legalisation for Foreign Public Documents* (Apostille Convention) of a new implementation of the e-APP.

Israel

Israel has begun issuing e-Apostilles, with the following conditions:

1. An e-Apostille may be issued on:
 - a. Electronic notarial certificates.
 - b. Electronic public documents from the Inheritance Registrar and the Corporations Authority.
2. e-Apostilles are issued by the Ministry of Justice as a Competent Authority for Israel.
3. e-Apostilles may be issued as of 21 December 2021.
4. At a later stage, e-Apostilles may be issued on additional electronic public documents.

Israel has also implemented an e-Register, with the following conditions:

1. The e-Register is available at <https://eregister.justice.gov.il/>.
2. All e-Apostilles issued by Israel will be available for verification on the e-Register.

Israël

Israël a commencé à délivrer des Apostilles électroniques, avec les conditions suivantes :

3. Une Apostille électronique peut être délivrée sur ;
 - a. les certificats notariés électroniques.
 - b. les actes publics électronique délivrés par la *Inheritance Registrar and the Corporations Authority*.
4. Les Apostilles électroniques sont délivrées par le ministère de la Justice en tant qu'Autorité compétente pour l'Israël.
5. Les Apostilles électroniques peuvent être délivrées depuis le 21 décembre 2021.
6. À un stade ultérieur, des Apostilles électroniques pourront être délivrées sur d'autres actes publics électroniques.

2. Les Apostilles électroniques délivrées par Israël seront disponibles pour vérification sur l'e-Registre.
