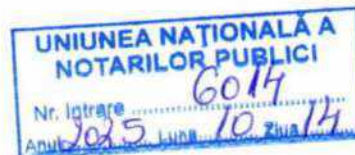

Stimate domnule Președinte,

Vă prezentăm, în anexă, Nota Verbală nr. E/25-141/12.09.2025 transmisă de Ambasada Mongoliei în Bulgaria (acreditată pentru România) și care vizează implementarea în Mongolia a **Sistemului Integrat de Servicii Publice (eMongolia)** în conformitate cu prevederile *Convenției de la Haga din 5 octombrie 1961 de eliminare a cerinței de legalizare a documentelor publice străine, intrată în vigoare la 27 mai 2025*.

Acest program va permite autentificarea apostilelor și legalizărilor prin intermediul unor mecanisme de verificare online, disponibile la adresa <https://e-mongolia.mn/check>, inclusiv prin scanarea codului QR.

Ambasada Republicii Mongolia în Bulgaria informează în legătură cu un proces de tranziție pentru acest sistem și implementarea începând cu luna septembrie 2025 a programului unei noi apostile electronice.

Se anexează un specimen al **formatului noii apostile electronice, pagina cu datele de identificare ale solicitantului, respectiv pagina conținând informații explicative privind eficacitatea apostilei și instrucțiuni de verificare.**

Vă adresăm rugămintea de a confirma dacă apostilele emise digital prin sistemul eMongolia pot fi considerate ca având aceeași valoare juridică cu apostilele tradiționale, eliberate pe format hârtie, pentru a fi în măsură să furnizăm un răspuns părții mongole, sau dacă se menține răspunsul anterior comunicat de UNNPR, cu privire la recunoașterea documentelor apostilate electronic emise de Statul Israel.

In accordance with the Hague Convention and national legislation, the use of electronic documents is permitted. Therefore, the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mongolia has implemented the certification of 12 types of references and statements issued from the Integrated System of Public Services (eMongolia) through Apostille authentication starting from September of 2025, with plans to gradually improve this service in the future.

"Apostille" certificates, references and statements issued from this system can be verified for authenticity by accessing the link <https://e-mongolia.mn/check> or by scanning the QR code.

Therefore, we kindly request your urgent confirmation from the relevant authority on clarifying whether the "Apostille" certificates issued from Integrated System of Public Services, which are in digital form, can be considered equal in status to traditional paper-based "Apostille" certificates.

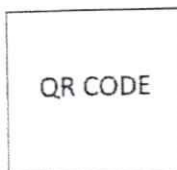

Notification regarding the electronic Apostille Programme (e-APP)

The Permanent Bureau of the HCCH is pleased to inform the Competent Authorities designated under the *Convention of 5 October 1961 Abolishing the Requirement of Legalisation for Foreign Public Documents* (Apostille Convention) of a new implementation of the e-APP.

Mongolia

Mongolia has begun issuing e-Apostilles, with the following conditions:

1. An e-Apostille may be issued on the following documents through the Integrated System of Public Services (eMongolia):
 - Reference on civil and criminal records;
 - Social insurance contributions reference;
 - Reference to outstanding payments mandated by court ruling (for citizens);
 - Reference of marital status;
 - Reference provided to unmarried persons;
 - Reference of birth certificate;
 - National ID card reference;
 - Reference form for old age pension;
 - Reference form for survivor's pension;
 - Reference form for disability pension;
 - Driver's reference, information; and
 - Certification of immunization.
2. e-Apostilles will be issued by the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mongolia as the Competent Authority for Mongolia.
3. e-Apostilles will be issued as of 4 September 2025.

Mongolia has implemented an e-Register, with the following conditions:

1. The e-Register is available at <https://e-mongolia.mn/check>.
2. All e-Apostilles issued by the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mongolia will be available for verification on the e-Register.
3. Paper Apostilles may be verified by contacting the relevant Competent Authority.

Mongolie

La Mongolie a commencé à émettre des e-Apostilles, selon les conditions suivantes :

 - Extrait d'acte de naissance
 - Attestation relative à la carte nationale d'identité
 - Formulaire de référence pour l'octroi d'une pension de vieillesse
 - Formulaire de référence pour l'octroi d'une pension de réversion
 - Formulaire de référence pour l'octroi d'une pension d'invalidité
 - Attestation relative au permis de conduire et aux informations afférentes
 - Certificat de vaccination
5. Les e-Apostilles seront émises par le Département consulaire du ministère des Affaires étrangères de Mongolie en tant qu'Autorité compétente pour la Mongolie.
6. Les e-Apostilles seront émises à partir du 4 septembre 2025.

La Mongolie a mis en place un e-Registre, selon les conditions suivantes :

Mongolia

Mongolia ha comenzado a expedir Apostillas electrónicas, según las siguientes condiciones:

1. Las e-Apostillas podrán emitirse para los siguientes documentos a través del Sistema Integrado de Servicios Públicos (eMongolia):
 - Certificados de antecedentes civiles y penales
 - Constancia de aportes al seguro social
 - Constancia de pagos pendientes ordenados por sentencia judicial (para ciudadanos)
 - Certificación del estado civil
 - Certificación para personas solteras
 - Certificación de nacimiento
 - Constancia de documento nacional de identidad
 - Formulario de constancia para pensión por vejez
 - Formulario de constancia para pensión por viudez
 - Formulario de constancia para pensión por discapacidad
 - Certificación e información de conductor
 - Certificación de vacunación
2. Las e-Apostillas serán emitidas por el Departamento Consular del Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores de Mongolia, en calidad de Autoridad Competente.
3. La emisión de e-Apostillas comenzará el 4 de septiembre de 2025.

Mongolia ha implementado un registro electrónico, según las siguientes condiciones:

1. El registro electrónico está disponible en <https://e-mongolia.mn/check>.
2. Todas las e-Apostillas emitidas por el Departamento Consular del Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores de Mongolia estarán disponibles para verificación en dicho Registro.
3. Las Apostillas en papel podrán verificarse contactando a la Autoridad Competente correspondiente.
